Responsibilities of a Supervising Agent

- 1. At no time is a minor child to be left alone with the defendant.
- 2. At no time is a minor child to be allowed to go to bedrooms, bathrooms, or other areas of the residence with the defendant without the supervising agent being present.
- 3. At no time will the defendant be allowed to take care of a minor child's basic needs, including but not limited to bathing, diaper changes and potty training.
- 4. The supervising agent must have the minor child and the defendant in their sight at all times and must be able to observe all activities.
- 5. At no time will the defendant be allowed to remain at the same residence as the minor child over night.
- 6. The dates and times and frequency of the requested supervised contact should be approved by the U.S. Probation Office in advance.
- 7. I understand that the listed minors are the only minors that the defendant is allowed to have contact with.
- 8. As a supervising agent, I am acting as a responsible adult who is aware of the offense of the defendant, I understand how a child can be victimized, I have no problem distinguishing right from wrong and I willingly accept responsibility for supervising the contact.
- 9. I agree to follow the guidelines to ensure the safety of minor children that the defendant has requested to visit.
- 10. I agree to report any questionable behaviors of the defendant to the supervising U.S. Probation Officer.
- 11. I acknowledge I have reviewed a copy of the defendant's Safety Plan with the defendant and the supervising U.S. Probation Officer.
